

Module 1

Accuro EMR for Clinic Settings (39.5 hours

 Use built-in AI features to automate administrative tasks
- Navigate appointment scheduling and clinic workflows Outcome: Students gain familiarity with systems comparable to Telus EMR, OSCAR, and other commonly used Canadian platforms.

Module 2

Hospital-Based EHR and Unit Clerk Simulation (39.5 hours)

This module prepares students for unit clerk and administrative roles in hospitals and long-term care settings by simulating Electronic Health Record (EHR)

- Patient admissions, discharges, and bed planning
 Managing diagnostic orders and interdepartmental communication
 Tracking patient movements and documenting care
- Supporting multi-provider coordination within EHR systems
- Using hospital-style EHR platforms such as Epic, Meditech, Cerner, and Connect
- Outcome: Students complete training with the technical confidence needed for institutional healthcare settings.
